Today, HHPA informed ITM that HHPA is continuing the suspension of ITM's operations on the HHPA rail line. This means that ITM will not be operating the FairTrain this year. We will continue to work with HHPA, its rail consultant, and others associated with HHPA. ITM's goal continues to be to provide such information and take such other actions as needed to enable HHPA to lift the suspension.

Our record of safety is unparalleled in our over 30-year operating history, and we will continue that record as we go forward.
